<p>Agenda</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Welcome/Icebreaker: Question Box - Pre-Surveys: - College Options: Discussion & Mascot Bingo! <p>+Q: Who knows how many college options there are? -There are so many different colleges to choose from and we don't have time to talk about them all but there are a 5 types of colleges that we want to talk about.</p> <p>+Q: Does anyone know what they are? -Technical, Community College, Private Career School, 4 Year College, University (Public & Private) w/ Examples</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Why it is important to start researching early - Who they can talk to about College - Can general talk about the different degree options connected with the school since there were questions on how you get a Bachelors and Masters Degree last week <p>+Play Mascot Bingo – Can refer back to College options with the different types of Colleges on the Bingo cards</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Winners can pick a prize at the end of the day <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scholarships! <p>+Q: Does anybody know how you can pay for college? - General Overview of Financial Aid (FAFSA: free money) They cannot apply until their senior year but just something to quickly bring in so it's something they know about. Make it simple.</p> <p>- Q: What about scholarships? Who can tell me what a scholarship is? This is something they can start applying for now.</p> <p>+ College Bound Info! They can apply for this scholarship in 7th & 8th Grade. Not too far from now! More info on handout.</p> <p>+ Doodle For Google Scholarship Challenge: “What Make Me...Me?” Students will interview each other to find their interests, personality, like and dislikes. Partner up and ask at least 5 questions to get to know partner. Examples Color that describes you, what do you like to do for fun, What do you like most about school, why do you like being a kid, what superhero/animated character would you like to be.</p> <p>+Brainstorm what they would want it to look like</p>

Coach & Coordinator Notes/Questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be sure you have enough copies of all materials. Extra copies would be a benefit as well. • I had 10 different Bingo Cards for a class of 30ish students. There were 3 winners for one game. May want more cards made if you want a single winner. I think it worked well for us though since we only had time for one game. • Coaches felt there were too many schools included in the Bingo options and it took a while to go through them all. Double check to only include schools that are on the cards you use. • I did not have time to make the cards I wanted. Instead they were scraps of paper. If you have time think about creating cards for you and future use • Leave early to pass out supplies and talk about last minute additions/changes/questions (Arrive 10 Minutes early) • Students were excited about another week. They look forward to the chance to win a prize • We included a questions box for the year which will hopefully help to save time during workshops • Adjust timing for Google Scholarship Presentation. More time to explain & talk in small groups about the topic for that years Google Scholarship • Ask teachers in advance if you can use their projector to better show class bingo cards
